



Cardiff Parkway

SLC Property is supporting the delivery of a new sustainable transport hub and 90,000m2 of commercial space. Background

Cardiff Parkway is a new railway station proposed within the Cardiff Hendre Lakes development and is expected to welcome more than 800,000 passengers per year. The site provides for the much-needed eastward expansion of Cardiff to meet growing demand for commercial space and improved connectivity.

SLC Property's engagement started in 2018 and is focused on ensuring that all the planning and environmental aspects of the scheme are integrated with other requirements for constructing a new rail station.
